MAN ARRESTED ON SEX CHARGES

A 41-year-old Bradenton man was arrested Sunday after police say he propositioned a 15-year-old girl to have sex with him on camera for money.

The Manatee County Sheriff's Office said Jaimie Rivera stared at and bothered, on several occasions, a 15-year-old girl at his apartment complex's pool in west Bradenton. Investigators said Rivera asked the girl if she would undress or have sex with him in a film for \$1,000. The girl told investigators that Rivera, who listed his occupation as being a "mental health technician" at Manatee Palms Youth Services in Bradenton, would stare at her, and one time stroked her leg.

Rivera was arrested on charges of lewd and lascivious battery, stalking and battery. He is being held at the Manatee County jail on \$11,500 bond.

Shots fired at two people

Two people were followed and shot at early Tuesday morning on 27th Avenue West.

The Manatee County Sheriff's Office said a 25-year-old man and a 22-year-old woman were followed in their car from the 5300 block of 14th Street West to the 1200 block of 27th Avenue West by a person in a blue Chevrolet.

Deputies said the Chevrolet passed the two people at a stop sign, stopped and then the driver got out and fired several shots at them.

No one was injured.

Mobile home fire

A mobile home was damaged Friday afternoon after the kitchen caught fire.

Cedar Hammock Fire Rescue was called to a home in J & N's Mobile Home Park, 1721 Cortez Road W. When firefighters arrived, they found smoke pouring from the home.

Firefighters searched the home but found no one home. There were no reports of injuries.
